



## Information Sheet for Owners

We welcome well behaved dogs - **no extra charge (for two or less)**. Other animals are welcome by arrangement.

As well as our large paddock, which is fenced off, there are many lovely dog walking areas nearby. We have a number of walking books; showing walks and beaches suitable for dogs which you can borrow.

We know of lots of places that have deposits, penalties, large extra charges for dogs and seemingly reams of rules and regulations, we try not to be like this. We do however have some simple requirements for dog owners which we would appreciate you adhering to so that we can continue to offer the facilities and no additional charges etc that we do...



Well-behaved dogs are welcome on the cottages, furnishings, grounds and other guests is observed at all times. Dogs must not be allowed to sleep on the beds (unless you supply your own linen). Please clean up your dog's hairs, messy paw marks etc.

There is a large paddock which is suitable for dog walking, just watch them around the separately fenced off pond area. Please clean up after your dog in all areas; we ask all guests to use "Poop Scoop Bags" and dispose of in the bin provided.

**Dogs should never be left unattended in the cottages.** Please remember dogs act differently when away from home and it is your responsibility for any damage they cause. Not all of our guests are dog lovers so we do not want unattended dogs barking, nor does our insurance fully cover us for any potential damage by dogs who may be left too long and/or who get distressed in a strange place.

There are local kennels that take dogs for the day for around £10 (please ask for details) and most local pubs accept dogs. We may be able to arrange dog sitting (again please ask for details).



As noted we do not charge for dogs (two or less) but please note that there is an option on the booking form so when booking please let us know you have a dog(s) so we are aware when you arrive.

All dogs other than defined "fighting breeds" are welcome but we do expect large dogs to be well trained and leashed where appropriate so that they do not jump up and potentially intimidate other guests.

Please do not forget to bring things that your dog may need. Please bring their own bedding, sofa covers and feeding bowls and remember to bring their lead. We do, however, have spares if you forget.

Except for The Willows which has its own garden please ensure that your dog is kept on a lead around the cottages, dogs can be off their leads in the one+ acre paddock area.

Obviously the vast majority of our animal visitors are dogs so for other animals please ring to discuss their / our requirements.
